Thunderbird International Film Festival Tickets On Sale Now

Tickets are now on sale for the Fifth Annual Thunderbird Film Festival, which runs from June 1-5 in Cedar City. The Festival will feature over fifty independent films in four days displayed with state-of-the art digital projection in the Sharwan Smith Theater on the SUU campus.

Attendees will experience student and independent films from around the world and will participate in a question and answer session with the featured filmmakers. Films are shown in twelve different screening blocks, with screenings beginning on Wednesday, June 1 at 9 p.m., and screening blocks starting at 11 a.m., 2 p.m., 6 p.m., and 9 p.m. on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.

Tickets are \$5 per screening block or \$2 for SUU students, or \$20 for a Moviemania pass, which grants you access to all screenings and Thunderbird Festival events and offers a \$40 savings to film fans. Tickets can be purchased at The Grind Coffee House, Groovacious, or at the door.

“We are excited about this year’s wide variety of entries,” said Mariam Arthur, Executive Director and Founder of the Thunderbird International Film Festival. “It is always exciting to see what new works are being produced by students and independent filmmakers across the country and around the world.”

Thunderbird is an authentic film festival showcasing student and independent films in a personal “down-home” atmosphere. The festival is comprised of three competitions: Thunderbird (main), High School, and Screenplay. The main competition divisions and categories are designed for fair adjudication. The Thunderbird Festival is hosted by Southern Utah University, and is supported by Communication Department and the College of Performing and Visual Arts.
